**A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ST. JOHNS CITY CHARTER
AMENDMENT AUTHORIZING THE LEVY
OF UP TO AN ADDITIONAL 3 MILLS FOR 5 YEARS
DEDICATED TO STREET AND SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS**

Section 1 of the general taxation chapter of the City Charter currently provides the amount annually levied for property taxes shall not exceed ten mills by operation of law.

The proposed amendment would add section 1(b) to the general taxation chapter to authorize the levy of up to an additional 3 mills for 5 years, beginning in the 2018 tax levy year and running through the 2022 tax levy year, inclusive. The sole purpose of this additional millage is for street and sidewalk improvements throughout the city, including curbs, gutters and drainage facilities as needed.
