

**ORDINANCE NO. 504**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 108, ANIMALS, ARTICLE I THEREOF, OF THE ST. JOHNS CITY CODE BY ADDING THERETO SECTION 9.96 TO REQUIRE THE IMMEDIATE COLLECTION OF ANIMAL WASTE AND PROPER DISPOSAL THEREOF, WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ST. JOHNS.

THE CITY OF ST. JOHNS ORDAINS:

That Chapter 108, Article I in General, shall be amended by adding thereto Section 9.96.

Section 1. That Chapter 108, ANIMALS, of the St. Johns City Code shall be amended by adding Section 9.96 thereto as follows:

9.96 Collection and Disposal of Animal Wastes

(1) Any person walking an animal or allowing them access to or on properties not owned by them, private or public, shall be required to collect solid animal wastes immediately and properly dispose of the same.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after passage.




