

ORDINANCE NO. 507

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 107, JUNK AUTOMOBILES, THEREOF, OF THE CITY OF ST. JOHNS CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 9.61 TO INCLUDE OPERABLE UNLICENSED MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE DEFINITION OF JUNK AUTOMOBILES, WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ST. JOHNS.

THE CITY OF ST. JOHNS ORDAINS:

That Chapter 107, JUNK AUTOMOBILES, shall be amended by including operable unlicensed motor vehicles within the definition of Junk Automobiles.

Section 1. That Chapter 107, JUNK AUTOMOBILES, Section 9.61 Open Storage Unlawful of the St. Johns City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

9.61 Open Storage Unlawful. It is hereby declared unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to store on, place on, or permit to be stored on or placed on, or allow to remain on any platted or unplatted parcel of land, a dismantled, partially dismantled, abandoned, operable unlicensed or inoperable motor vehicle or any parts thereof, which platted or unplatted parcel of land is located in the City of St. Johns, Clinton County, Michigan, unless said dismantled, partially dismantled, operable unlicensed or inoperable motor vehicle or parts thereof, shall be kept in a wholly enclosed garage or other wholly enclosed structure.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after passage.




